Yellowknife Shooting Club Basic Range Safety Rules

1. Always treat firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Muzzles will be pointed downrange and in a safe direction at all times.
3. Always unload the firearm, remove cartridges and/or magazines, and then open actions when:
 - a) firearm is not in use,
 - b) the command 'Unload' has been given,
 - c) before putting the firearm down, or
 - d) when shooting is completed.
4. Never touch equipment or firearms on the bench or otherwise when people are downrange. If moving to the firing line when people are downrange, all firearms must remain cased.
5. No one may go forward of the firing line before the range has been checked and the Range Officer has given the command 'All Clear'.
6. Never touch anyone's firearm(s) or equipment without permission and then only after proofing the firearm.
7. All shooting must be directed within the confines of the backstop.
8. If two or more shooters are present on the firing line, one must act as Range Officer if a certified Range Officer is not present.
9. All shooters must wear appropriate eye and ear protection. All spectators are encouraged to wear appropriate eye and ear protection.
10. No steel targets closer than 10 meters (33 feet) from the firing line will be fired upon.
11. No glass targets will be permitted on this range.
12. All gun laws will be obeyed. If in doubt, contact the Chief Firearms Officer for clarification.
13. Membership cards or guest cards must be displayed openly.
14. All persons under 19 years of age must be accompanied by an adult on all ranges.
15. Read and abide by range instructions posted on each range.

Infractions to the above rules can lead to suspension from this range and/or possible criminal charges.

Member's signature on the application page indicates that the member has read and understands these safety rules. It is the responsibility of the signing member to ensure that junior members under their supervision understand and follow these rules.
